

Stop 1: National Museum of the Great Lakes

- Address: 1701 Front Street Toledo, Ohio
- Website: nmgl.org
- Notes: A great place to start your tour and learn about the maritime history of the Great Lakes.

Stop 2: Toledo Harbor Lighthouse

- Viewable From: Maumee Bay State Park Beach, 1400 State Park Road, Oregon, Ohio
- **Tours:** Inside is not currently open to visitors. Viewable via boat or with binoculars from the beach.
- **Special Access:** Boat tours available during the Toledo Lighthouse Festival (check website for dates).

Stop 3: Port Clinton Lighthouse

- Location: Waterworks Park, West State Route 163, Port Clinton, Ohio
- **Tours:** Inside tours available during the Port Clinton Lighthouse Festival and on Saturdays, from noon until 5 p.m., Memorial Day through September 2.

Stop 4: South Bass Island Lighthouse

- Location: 2368 Langram Road, Put-In-Bay, Ohio
- Note: You'll need to take a ferry to South Bass Island.

Stop 5: Marblehead Lighthouse

- Location: Marblehead Lighthouse State Park, 110 Lighthouse Dr, Marblehead, Ohio
- Tours: Open daily from 12pm-4pm, Memorial Day Weekend through Labor Day

Stop 6: Vermilion Lighthouse

- Location: 480 Main Street, Vermilion, Ohio
- Tours: Inside not open to the public

Stop 7: Lorain Harbor Lighthouse

- Location: View from Mile Long Pier, Lorain, Ohio
- **Tours:** Boat tours available; Check current events and schedules at: lorainlighthouse.com/upcomingevents
- Viewing: Best viewed with binoculars from the pier or by tour boat.

Stop 8: Fairport Harbor West Breakwater Lighthouse

- Location: View from Headlands Dunes State Nature Preserve 9601 Headlands Road, Mentor, Ohio
- Tours: Inside not accessible Private Residence

Stop 9: Fairport Harbor Lighthouse & Marine Museum

- Location: 129 2nd St, Fairport Harbor, Ohio
- **Museum & Tours:** Tours of the lighthouse and museum are available year round. Visit website for more information.

NOTES:

- **Best Time to Visit:** Late spring through early fall (May-September) offers the best weather and most tour availability.
- Admission Info: Check individual websites for ticket prices or free admission policies.
- Travel Tips:
 - Some lighthouses are only viewable from a distance or via boat.
 - Allow extra time for ferry rides (South Bass Island).
 - It can get windy out there, you might want to take a jacket.
 - Pack binoculars and a camera!
