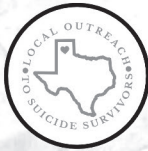

The Space They Left

A three-part series from
Panhandle  PBS



This September, Panhandle PBS presents “THE SPACE THEY LEFT,” a three-part series that takes an unflinching yet compassionate look at suicide through the lens of a public health issue, and gives a voice to the people often left in the shadows: suicide loss survivors.

According to multiple studies, each suicide impacts about 135 people in the community on average. In the weeks and months after a loss, those left behind face a gauntlet of guilt, confusion, and emotional turmoil that is unique to suicide grief. On top of that, they now face a significantly increased risk for having thoughts of their own suicide and potentially acting on them. Yet many communities lack resources tailored to address suicide loss or a space for survivors to talk about their struggles.

“THE SPACE THEY LEFT,” explores this hidden crisis through intimate conversations with survivors as they share their experience in the months and years after their lives were changed forever. The series features forensic suicidologist Dr. Frank Campbell, a past president of the American Association of Suicidology and founder of the LOSS Team (Local Outreach to Suicide Survivors) model, who provides expert insight into the postvention space of suicide and how LOSS teams connect loss survivors to resources at the scene of a tragedy. The series also sits down with Dr. Jenna

Maynard Baker, CEO of the American Association of Suicidology, who shares her perspective on suicide prevention strategies, intergenerational trauma, and the critical need for postvention resources. Finally, the series takes a look at the real-life impact of the Amarillo Area LOSS team, the resources they connect survivors to, and the space it provides for suicide loss survivors to share their grief among peers.

Episode One premieres Thursday, September 10

Episode Two on September 17

Episode Three on September 24.

All episodes air at 7 p.m. on Panhandle PBS and will also be available on the Panhandle PBS YouTube channel.

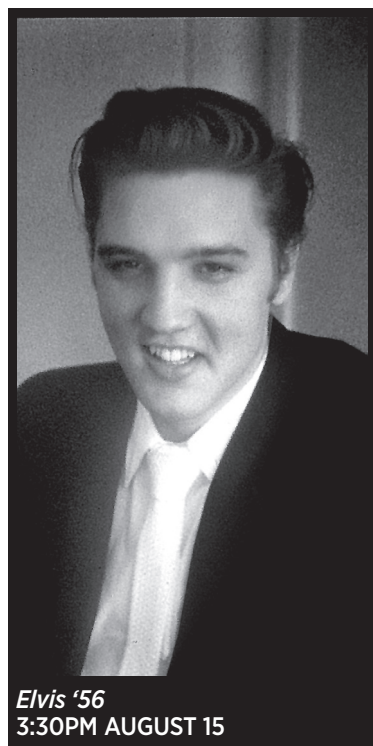
