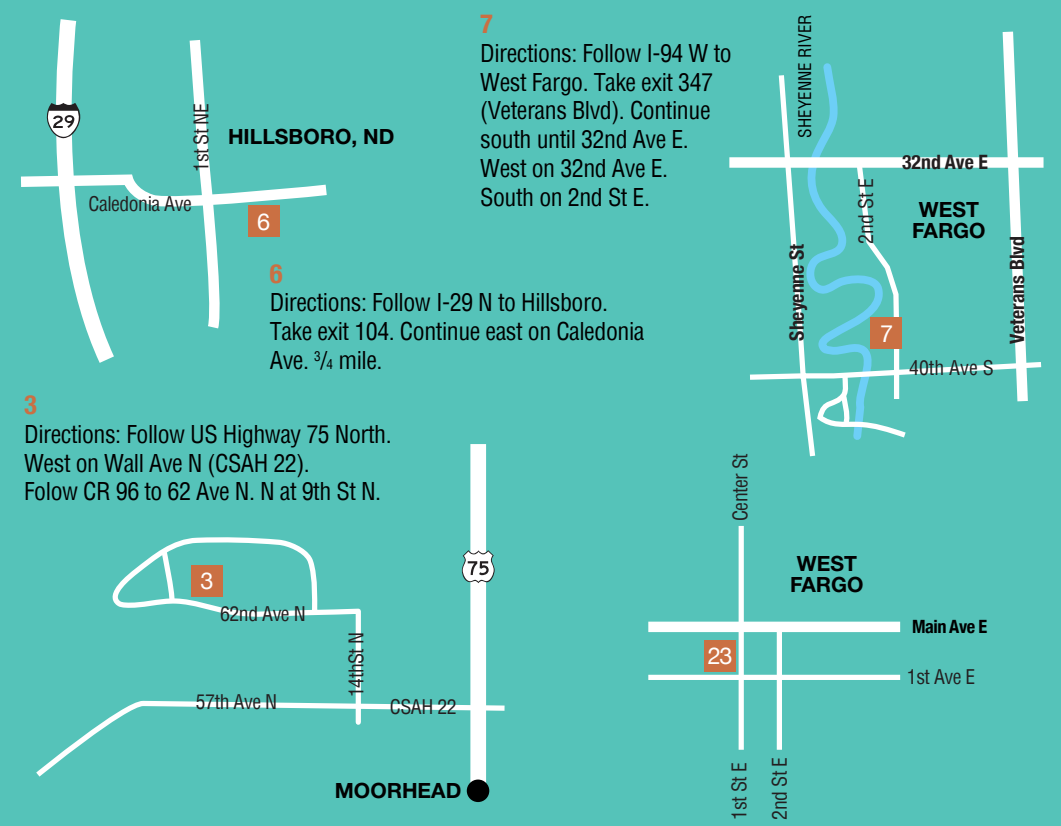
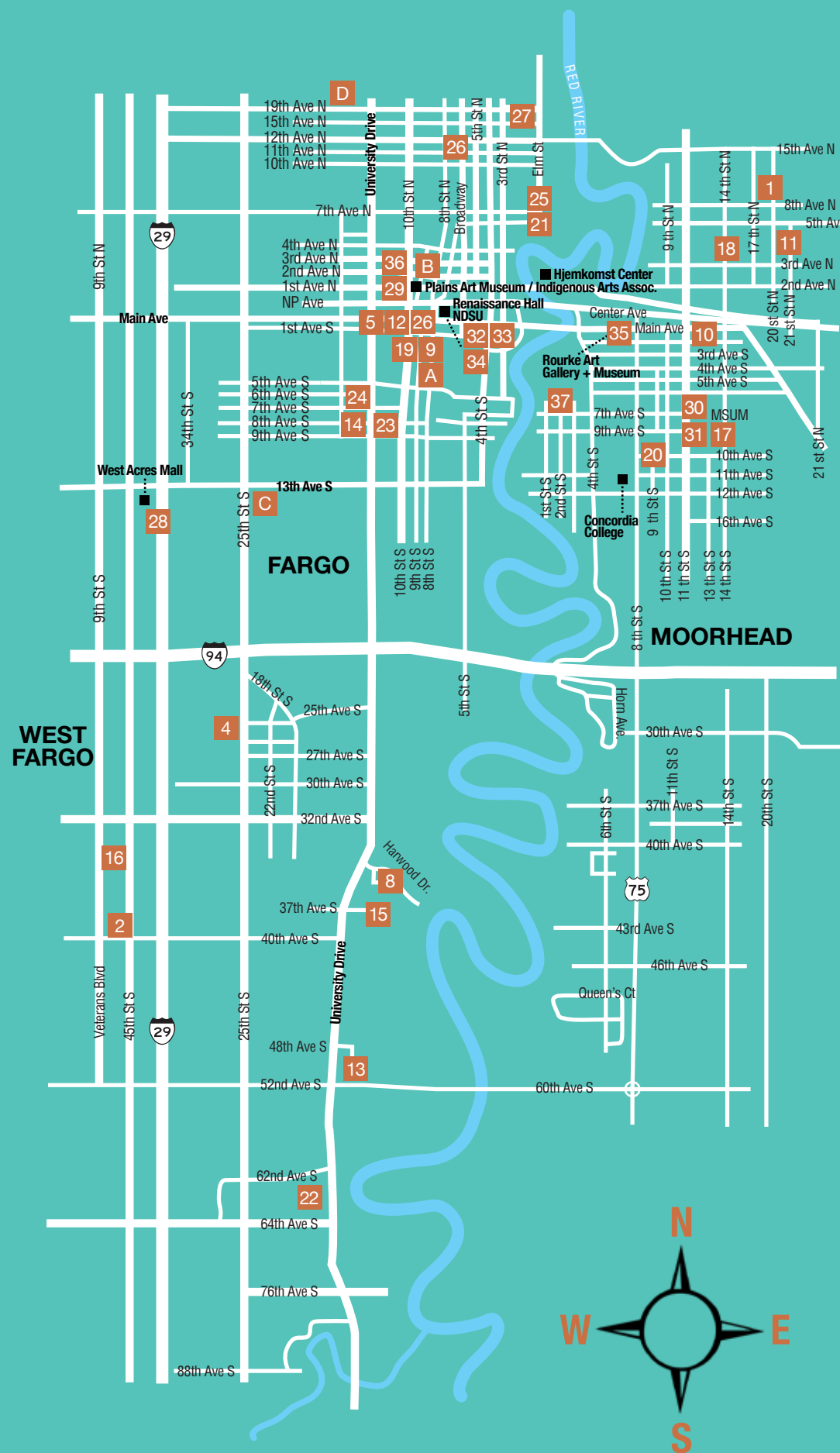

Hosted by Essentia Health on South University in Fargo, the exhibition features original small-scale works by FM Visual Artists members in a wide variety of media, including painting, printmaking, photography, ceramics, fiber, jewelry, and mixed media. The intimate format encourages visitors to discover unique artwork while making original art accessible to new and experienced collectors alike.

ART ADVOCATES EXHIBITION

The Art Advocates Exhibition is a biennial exhibition celebrating the artwork of FM Visual Artists members who serve as educators, instructors, mentors, and advocates for the visual arts. Presented in partnership with the North Dakota Art Education Association (NDAEA) and hosted by West Acres Mall, the exhibition recognizes the individuals who dedicate their time and talents to inspiring creativity, encouraging artistic growth, and fostering an appreciation for the arts in classrooms, studios, community organizations, and beyond. By showcasing their own creative work, the exhibition highlights the powerful connection between teaching, advocacy, and artistic practice.

CONSTRAINT EXHIBITION

The FMVA Constraint Exhibition is a biennial exhibition that challenges artists to create new work within a shared creative constraint established by the FM Visual Artists Board of Directors. Whether the limitation is based on a theme, material, size, color palette, or creative process, the exhibition encourages artists to think beyond familiar approaches, experiment with new ideas, and discover innovative solutions through artistic problem-solving.

Presented in alternating years with the Art Advocates Exhibition, the Constraint Exhibition returns in 2027 with a brand-new challenge.

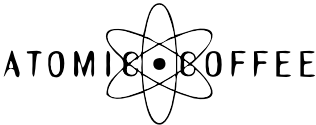
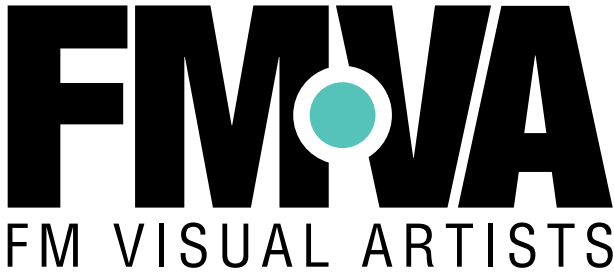
VISUAL TALKS LECTURE SERIES

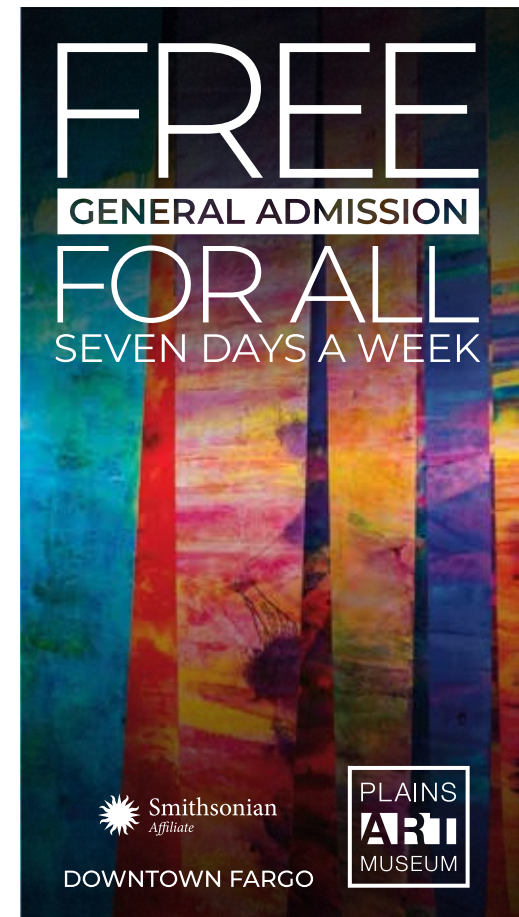

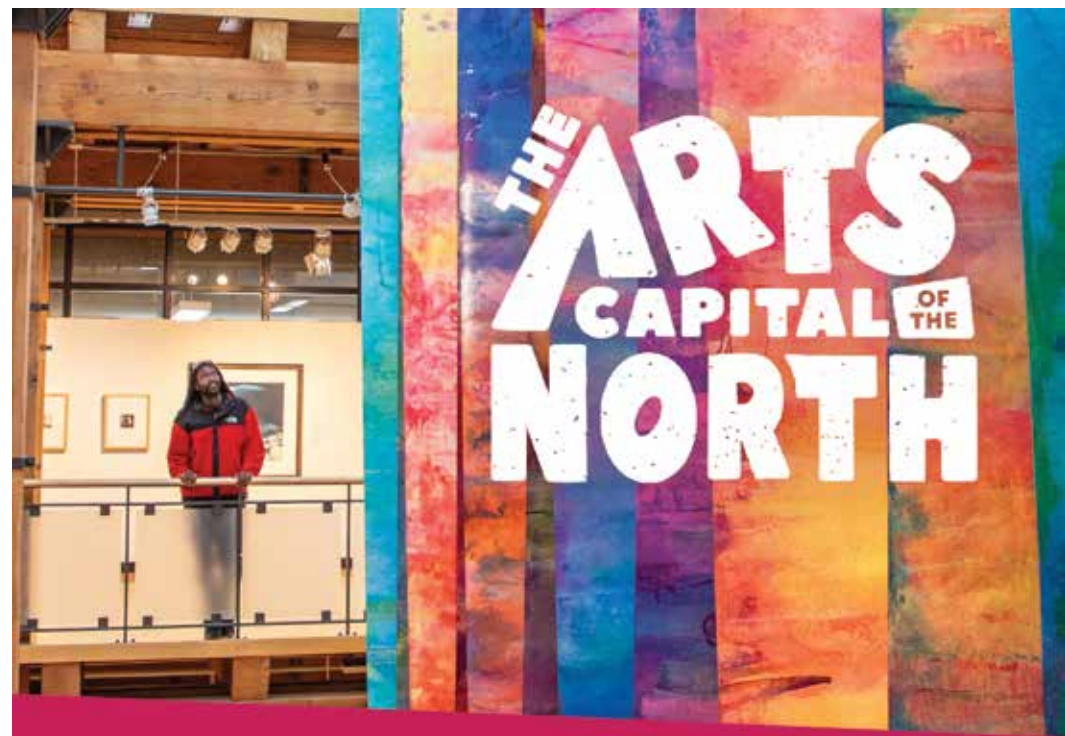

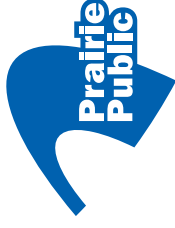
