In 1843, more than two decades after Jane Austen's death, her sister Cassandra burned much of their private correspondence. Why? No one knows for sure. Was it an act of protection, grief or a desire to shape her sister's legacy? That mystery lies at the heart of **Miss Austen**, the new **MASTERPIECE** series debuting **Sunday, May 4 at 9 p.m.** Keeley Hawes (**The Durrells in Corfu**) stars as Cassandra, joined by Patsy Ferran as a young Jane Austen, in a poignant, witty reimagining of the sisters' bond.

But speed and scale don't always equal substance. That's why the mission of public media remains so vital: to use our platforms not just to entertain, but to educate, inform and inspire.

That mission came into sharp focus for me again last month at The Big Party. As I spoke with public officials, community leaders, and supporters like you, I was struck by how many different ways Vegas PBS touches people's lives. From our trusted news and public affairs programs to lifelong learning and local storytelling, our work matters — and it's being noticed.

And we're not just on screen. We're in parks, libraries, classrooms and even on the water.
