

Missouri is consistently rated among the lowest-performing states in maternal healthcare, ranking 43rd in the nation for women's health and reproductive care, according to a 2024 report from the Commonwealth Fund. A Perinatal Quality Collaborative study found that of roughly 350 pregnancy-related deaths in Missouri between 2018 and 2022, 80% were preventable. In this program, leading experts from the Ozarks and beyond examine the driving factors behind these rankings and explore the ongoing efforts aimed at improving maternal health outcomes in Missouri.


