It has been a colorful showcase of upcoming shows, a behind-the-scenes look at station life, and a tangible connection between KSPS PBS and our members. Unfortunately, the loss of federal funding has forced KSPS PBS to reduce our budget by 20%. In order to protect the programs and services at the core of our mission, we must make difficult choices. Beginning in January, *Preview* will continue only as a very lean, black-and-white television listings booklet. While it won't include feature articles or photography, it will ensure that viewers who depend on printed schedules can still keep track of what's on air.

If you don't use the printed listings, we encourage you to let us know you'd like to stop receiving *Preview* in the mail. Doing so will help reduce costs and stretch your donation further to support the programs and services you care about most.


The American Revolution


Beginning Sunday, November 16 at 8pm/9mt

Repeats each day at 10pm/11mt, 1am/2mt, and 2am/3mt

This new six-part, 12-hour documentary series explores the country's founding struggle and its eight-year war for independence. The much-anticipated series, which has been in production for eight years, was directed and produced by Ken Burns, Sarah Botstein and David Schmidt and written by long-time collaborator Geoffrey C. Ward. The premiere airing marks the 250th anniversary of the start of the war, which began in the spring of 1775more than a year before the Declaration of Independence.

The American Revolution examines how America's founding turned the world upside-down. Thirteen British colonies on the Atlantic Coast rose in rebellion, won their independence, and established a new form of government that radically reshaped the continent and inspired centuries of democratic movements around the globe. An expansive look at the virtues and contradictions of the war and the birth of the United States of America. the film follows dozens of figures from a wide variety of backgrounds. Viewers will experience the war through the memories of the men and women who experienced it. At one time or another, the British Army occupied all the major population centers in the United States - including New York City for more than seven years. The American Revolution was a war for independence, a civil war, and a world war. It impacted millions - from Canada to the Caribbean and beyond. Few escaped its violence.

The Great Escaper tells the true story of Bernard Jordan who made global headlines in the summer of 2014. He had staged a "great escape" from his care home to join fellow war veterans on a beach in Normandy, commemorating their fallen comrades at the D-Day Landings 70th anniversary. While Bernie is on his trip to Normandy, Bernie's devoted wife, Irene recalls their younger days and falling in love during World War II. Bernie's story captured the imagination of the world as he embodied the defiant, "can-do" spirit of a generation that was fast disappearing. But of course, it wasn't the whole story. It was an inspirational but sanitized retelling of one man's need to come to terms with the lasting trauma of war.


