The latest episode in the series explores the remarkable lives of three women whose courage and creativity left a lasting imprint on the Treasure State. Nancy Cooper Russell, wife and business partner of artist Charles M. Russell, preserved and promoted his legacy while also shaping her own identity and vision. Fannie Sperry Steele, a fearless bronc rider rose to national fame at a time when women were rarely seen in the rodeo arena. Ella Knowles Haskell became Montana's first female lawyer and a political trailblazer. Through powerful storytelling, archival materials, and expert insight, this episode highlights the depth and diversity of Montana women's contributions to law, art, and western heritage.

Through their determination, resilience, and vision, these three women made a lasting impact on Montana's landscape. Helen Clarke, a woman of Blackfeet and White descent, became one of Montana's early female elected officials. Rose Hum Lee, a Chinese American shaped scholarly understanding of immigrant communities. Rose Gordon, a Black woman who uplifted her neighbors and fostered a sense of unity in White Sulphur Springs. Their stories, often overlooked, reveal the deep and enduring influence women have had on Montana's history.

A proposed 5,000-acre artificial intelligence (AI) data center near Broadview, a small town in rural Yellowstone County, Montana, has sparked debate regarding its potential impact on local infrastructure, water usage, and energy. The project is part of a larger trend of data centers targeting Montana, drawn by low taxes and available land, with projects also under consideration near Butte.

The debate surrounding these projects continues, with community members, environmental advocates, and state officials looking for ways to balance economic development with the responsible use of local resources.



As the Graham Company nears its landmark 100th anniversary, WE ARE OUR TIME offers a rare behind-the-scenes portrait of the company, exploring Graham's legacy through the dancers who embody her work today. For over three years Partisan Pictures embedded within the dance company, filming from rehearsal to premiere, across a global tour, and at home with family.

Graham's singular vision revolutionized dance. Often listed alongside artistic forces such as Picasso and Stravinsky, she upended classical tradition with a striking vocabulary of movement that favored emotional truth over beauty. "I was a heretic," Graham wrote, "I showed on stage what most people came to the theater to avoid." With one of the first racially integrated companies, dances that explore the female psyche, and works of political protest, Graham challenged mid-20th century audiences. She believed dance should be vital, not decorative, describing it as "an arrow pointing to life at an instant."

Martha Graham's legacy is not just a technique, but a demand: that art confront and reflect the world as it is. WE ARE OUR TIME captures the passion and urgency required to keep the company – and its founder's spirit – alive. For the vibrant dancers of the company, that urgency is lived in their bodies. They train for years for that one weightless moment on stage. Company member Alessio Crognale-Roberts summarizes this experience, "You're alive. You get everything out of yourself, even if it's sweat, even if it's pain. Like, I just give it all to you."
