Highway of Death The Montana stretch of US Highway 212 rolls through the peaceful hill country of southeastern Montana, crossing the Northern Cheyenne and Crow Reservations on its route to Wyoming and across the country. This rural, two-lane road is popular with semi-drivers; it's a more direct route east than the interstate. But the road has a different reputation with the people who live along it. They call it the Highway of Death. Crashes along 212 have claimed hundreds of lives and impacted every community along the 140-mile stretch of road. A ten-year safety study by the Montana DOT uncovered the many complex reasons for the continuing death toll. Despite millions of dollars of investment in improvements, the deaths continue and the communities have had enough. Students in the University of Montana School of Journalism's documentary film program created this powerful film told from the perspective of families who have lost loved ones on this deadly stretch of highway. Hidden Fire: The Great Butte Explosion On a winter's night in 1895, Butte's first company of professional firefighters prepared to suppress the flames in a burning warehouse. They had no way of knowing that an illegal and enormous supply of explosive powder was burning inside. By morning, Butte's unprecedented growth and development would have a darker side. Winter Song On the grayest days at the grayest hour a small gray bird sings as the shortest days of December descend on the landscape of Garter Creek; the fictional name of a real stream, as it winds through the landscape of Northwest Montana like the namesake snake. The dipper is just one of the many birds and creatures that call Garter Creek home. Garter Creek is not long, perhaps 2-1/2 miles, but there are four beaver lodges, a transient river otter (who later finds a partner), numerous whitetail deer, an incredible array of songbirds and waterfowl, including trumpeter swans, a pack of wolves, a red fox, a great horned owl and a barred owl, which all are found along the creek. WINTER SONG centers on the dippers, the otters, the beavers as they make their life in the harsh and almost always gray days in Northwest Montana -- from freezing rain to snowstorms and temperatures that drop one morning to 23 below zero. The Best Last Place This seguel to the award-winning SAVING THE BURG, captures the irony of frightening Covid closures followed by exploding change in a tiny Montana town. The drama of an epidemic akin to the Spanish flu is matched by unprecedented in-migration that threatens the soul of "Last Best" Montana. Airs 10/26 10am

108 Max Lane The value of land in Montana is generally increasing. The cost of taxes, utilities, and maintenance are also going up. This includes residential and commercial property, but it also includes agricultural real estate. That can make it tough for smaller ag producers to maintain viable operations, and many of the younger generations of agriculture families are choosing other ways to make a living. Max Robison is a fourthgeneration rancher and the second in his family to ranch in the Madison River Valley. He will likely be the last of his family to do so. As land prices soar, the centuries-old tradition of small-scale family-run ranches is fading out, yet that experience still holds relevance for the American way of life. From dawn to late night, through hard work, disappointments, during all seasons and weather, 108 Max Lane is a glimpse into Max's daily life and philosophic approach, as well as being a portrait of the challenges and rewards of ranching and the rural life in isolated Montana places. Before There Were Parks: Yellowstone and Glacier Through Native Eyes For more than 12,000 years, the Native people of the Intermountain West have called the lands known as Yellowstone and Glacier National Parks "home." This program explores modern Indigenous perspectives on these great wilderness areas and explores both the cultural divide that separates modern times from the not-so-distant past and recent efforts by the National Park Service and Native peoples to bring these disparate visions into greater harmony. 




