In 1950, a baseball manager pulled out his 16mm movie camera to capture two, shiny objects flying fast in tandem over Great Falls. After experts studied his film, no explanation could be made, therefore classifying the "Montana Film" as perhaps the first video-recorded UFOs.

In western Montana, the Bitterroot Salish were one of many tribes that peeled the bark or "scarred" certain trees. The bark provided food and various construction materials. We'll find some of the trees still standing as a living artifact and learn more about this tribal tradition.

High in the Pioneer Mountains on a bed of decomposed granite, rockhounds uncover quartz crystals – ranging from smoky gray to highly prized purple amethysts. Dig into this unique recreation site that the U.S. Forest Service has reserved for this special purpose.

In Southwest Montana's Flint Creek Range, we'll follow Justin Martin on the hunt for old glass insulators, pieces of history most people overlook. What begins with broken glass in the mountains leads to a remarkable collection, Montana power history, and a community of collectors gathered in Helena. John Twiggs hosts the program from the Pasture Drive-In Theater in Manhattan.

Outdoor recreation has long defined both community and tradition in the gateway communities surrounding Glacier National Park. Drawn by the promise of snow-covered peaks, clear rivers, and alpine trails, visitors and locals have sustained a booming economy built on skiing, hiking, and fishing. But as seasonal patterns grow increasingly unpredictable, the natural trends that once shaped life in Northwest Montana are beginning to shift. We trace the widespread effects of these changes on the people and industries that depend on the land and its resources. 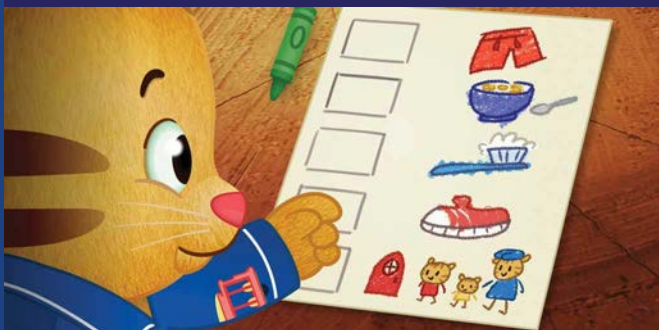

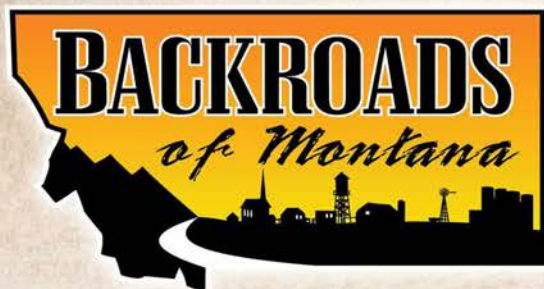

Jonnie Jonckowski is a Montana legend. She grew up with a passion for horses, natural athleticism and a relentless competitive drive. In her early twenties -- just when her dream of becoming an Olympic pentathlete was within reach -- she was permanently sidelined by a back injury. In search of a new challenge, Jonnie set her sights on an unlikely pursuit: professional bull riding. Jonnie's intrepid pursuit of a world title in the 1980s defied gender stereotypes and resulted in life-threatening injuries. It also ushered in a turbulent personal journey marked by poverty, heartbreak, and assault. And now, four decades later, Jonnie still rises to meet strenuous challenges: rescuing abandoned horses, battling natural disasters, and fiercely devoting herself to helping a community in need.
