Activity

Marble Run

Materials:

- Base-study box, large tray or large piece of cardboard
- Attachment tools-glue, scissors, masking tape
- Building materials-cardboard tubes (paper towel or toilet paper), small boxes, plastics cups, Styrofoam
- Decorating Supplies-markers, paint, stickers, scrap paper
- Marbles or similar items like bouncy balls or round beads

Directions:

Use recycled materials to build ramps and paths for marbles. Test how the marble runs, fix what doesn't work, and decorate the maze.




Caregiver Tips

Try different tube sizes and angles to help the marble run smoothly. Offer a variety of maze parts, such as a tissue box with a hole cut in the side or plastic cups with holes in the bottom.

Marble Painting

Place a sheet of paper inside a box lid or cardboard tray. Put small amounts of different paint colors into separate dishes. Dip a marble into one color, coating it fully, then drop it onto the paper. Use a different spoon for each color to keep paints from mixing. Tilt the box side to side and back and forth so the marble rolls and creates patterns.
