Caregiver Tips

Draw bunny ears on a toilet paper roll, then draw a line around the back of the roll connecting the ears. Cut along the line, including around the ears and across the back of the roll. The section between the ears can be straight or slightly curved like the top of a head. Paint the entire roll white and let it dry. Then draw eyes, a mouth, and whiskers on your bunny. Add pink paint inside the ears and for a small nose.

- Paintbrushes




Directions:
