Activity

3D Sculpture

Materials:

- Recycled and Found Items-cardboard tubes, egg cartons, plastic lids, old CDs, buttons, Styrofoam, fabric scraps, or paper rolls
- Attachment Tools-glue, tape, Velcro, modeling clay or magnets
- Decorative Items-stickers, beads, feathers, paint, markers or googly eyes

Directions:

Help your child choose a flat base for their sculpture. Using recycled and found “junk” materials, encourage imagination over perfection as they add pieces one at a time. Let them decide where and how to attach each piece, thinking about colors, shapes, and objects that represent them. Continue building until they feel their creation is complete.




Caregiver Tips
