Activity

Materials:

- Recycled materials such as clean empty cans, plastic containers, cardboard tubes, boxes, bottle caps or lids
- Building Tools-tape, glue, rubber bands
- Decorating supplies-markers, paint, stickers, yarn, or scrap paper
- Sound Makers-dry beans, rice, beads or buttons for shakers. Sticks, spoons or chopsticks for drumming and rubber bands for strumming a guitar.

Directions:

Assemble the pieces, making sure everything is sealed tightly. Decorate the instruments with stickers, crayons, or markers. Then start a jam session—tap, shake, strum, or bang the instruments, try different rhythms, and create a song together! 🎶



Make Musical Instruments

Ask questions such as:


- What sound do you want your instrument to make?
