## Activity

### Make a Button Picture

#### Materials:

- Buttons in different colors, sizes, and shapes
- Glue or glue stick
- A large piece of paper or poster board
- Markers or crayons

#### Directions:

Look through the buttons and sort by size, shape or color. Create a design. It can be a map, line, swirl or picture. Before glueing make sure you're happy with the placement. Once your buttons are glued down, add details around the buttons with markers or crayons.



Ask questions like:


- Where does your map go?
