## Caregiver Tips

- Decorate the tubes with paint, glitter, or other craft supplies.
- Cut a circle about 5 inches wide from a sheet of paper and shape it into a cone to create the rocket cap.
- Glue the cap to one end of the rocket. Add a straw "fuse" and tissue paper "flames" to the other end.
- Place the straws back over the skewers and allow the rocket to dry completely.

- Decorations such as glitter, sequins, ribbons, pipe cleaner and tissue paper

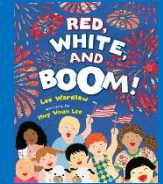
