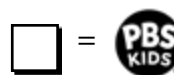
DECLARATIONS: BLACK AMERICANS AND THE REVOLUTIONARY WAR

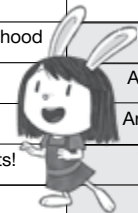
